

# DMEP Objective

This one day interactive course addresses the core competencies in disaster management and emergency preparedness as outlined by the ACS-COT Disaster Subcommittee. It concentrates on the principles of the all-hazards approach for the acute care provider.

*At the end of the course, DMEP students will be able to:*

- Describe the clinical problems, injury patterns, and issues that result from disasters.
- Discuss the role that surgeons and other acute care providers play in planning for, and responding to, mass casualty incidents and disasters.
- Articulate terms and principles of incident command.
- Explain the principles and challenges of disaster triage.
- Describe civilian and military assets available for support.
